					Look for New Moon Report from Israel starting the 29th day of each month.	Default New Moon is 30th day if not spotted on 29th.

All Biblical Holidays begin at sunset and continue until sunset the following day according to Israel's time zone.
 For example Israel is 11 hours ahead of Alaska, so all of Yahuwah's appointed times will begin 11 hours before this calendar says, if used according to Alaska's time zone.
